People's Choice victors included: Red Chili, 1st Place (and \$1,000) Shop Rite; 2nd Place (and \$300)- Pop's Hots; and 3rd Place- Trailer Trash Chili. Salsa: 1st Place (and \$400) Frank Benowitz; 2nd Place- Raymond Palazzo; and 3rd Place- Steve Riccelli.

Official ICS judges on hand were: Johanna Loddo (Chief Judge) and Nick Loddo, and the scorekeeper was Mary Ellen Weber.
